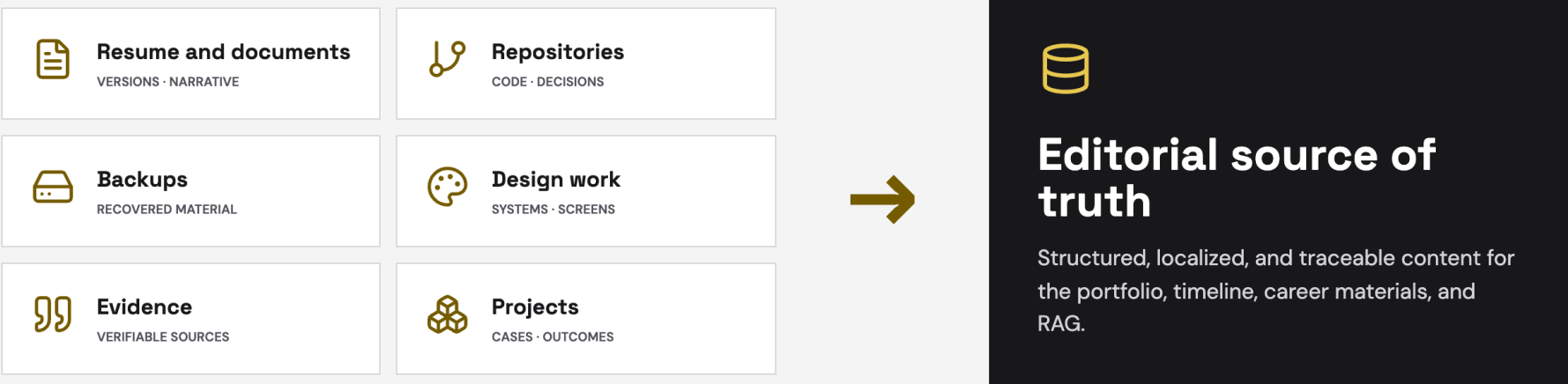

The experience existed across many formats, but there was no shared model for verifying, updating, and reusing it.



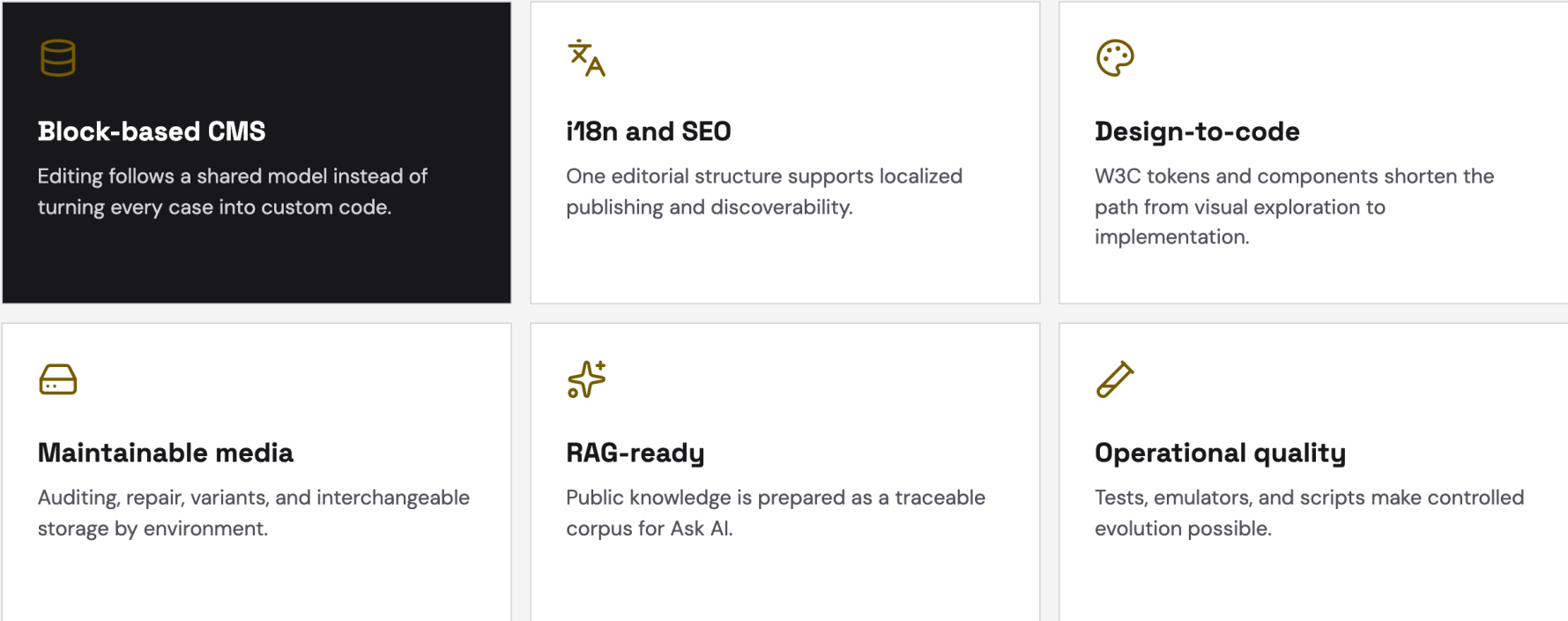
02 Content as data
